Happy Independence Day holiday weekend and welcome to the July 2026 edition of the AAPA Newsletter! As your President, I am pleased to be able to bring you this news



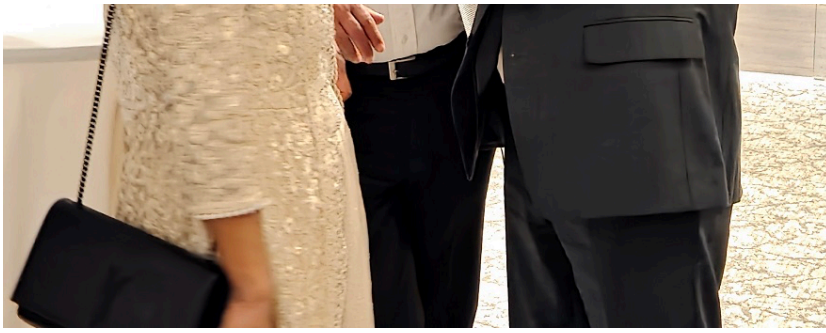

ANNUAL MEETING

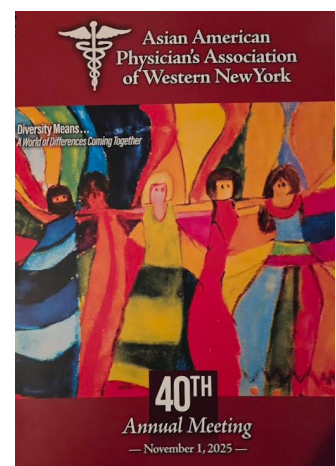
